JEROME RACING RULES & CONDITIONS

1. This Futurity and Derby is open only to Quarter Horses registered with the AQHA.
2. All races will be conducted under the rules of the Idaho State Racing Commission and the AQHA.
3. Each trial shall consist of not more than eight (8) horses. The trials shall be raced under the same conditions as the finals. No more than then (8) shall be selected from the trials to participate in the finals. There will be no also eligible in the finals. If 30 or more enter the trials a futurity consolation will be conducted.
4. The decision of the Stewards and or the Idaho State Racing Commission shall be final in all matters. All fees and payments accepted only on the condition that all persons nominating or starting a horse in this event agree to abide by the decision of the Stewards and/or the Idaho State Racing Commission.
5. Entries in the trials owned by the same owner or trained by the same trainer will be split if possible.
6. Should a horse be disqualified in the trials, he shall be given the time of the horse he is placed behind plus .001 seconds.
7. In the event of the timer malfunction, the stewards will revert to hand times to determine qualifiers.
8. Should the front gates fail to open in front of a horse during the running of the trials or stakes, the horse shall be declared a nonstarter and no liability will be incurred beyond the return of all payments that have been paid in on such horse.
9. Purse distribution for the Futurity and Derby shall pay (8) monies as follows: 40%, 20%, 10%, 9%, 6%, 5%, 5%, 5%.
10. Jerome Horse Racing Association reserve the right to cancel or postpone these Stakes races for any reason it deems good and sufficient and JHRA agrees to return, to the horsemen, all nominating and/or sustaining fees that have been paid in, less 10% for office expense.
11. The signature represents that he/or she is familiar with the rules and regulations governing Quarter Horse Racing by the Idaho State Racing Commission, JHRA and the sponsoring track and such persons agree to comply with the decision of the Board of Stewards and/or the Idaho State Racing Commission.
12. 15% will be deducted to defray expenses out of nominating and sustaining fees.
13. Nominating and sustaining payments made through the United States Mail must be postmarked or direct payment must be received by the payment deadline.
14. Official Registration papers (not copies) must be filed with the racing office at the subject meet prior to starting.
15. There will be no refund of nomination or sustaining fee for horses failing to meet qualifications. Horses sold after nominations are still eligible to participate, providing all rules are complied with.
